Purpose: The City and U.S. Customs now desire to amend the latest Agreement to provide a nine-month extension to the existing term. The term will be effective November 26, 2012 and will terminate on August 25, 2013. U.S. Customs will pay the City a rental fee of \$18, 178.315 per month.

The nine-month extension is required because U.S. Customs has decided to lease new office space outside the airport and need sufficient time to complete the build-out and relocation of their operations to the new location. Continuity of their services is essential to the airport community, the general public, and to the employees officed at the World Port office park.
