21	meeting, including any public hearings,-by electron	onic means during work travel, personal or
22	medical necessity pursuant to Rule 9.7, or if auth-	orized by the Council President.
23	(a) Work travel is official city business t	hat is more than 50 miles from Denver city limits
24	to attend conferences, trainings, meetings, or eve	ents, provided such travel is in compliance with
25	the City's fiscal rules and is related to the official of	or ceremonial duties of the member.
26	(b) Personal necessities are personal a	and family events that prevent the member from
27	attending in person but do not prevent the member	er from fully participating in the meeting.
28	Examples include taking care of an ill family mem	ber or being out of town for a funeral.
29	(c) Medical necessities are medical iss	ues that prevent the member from attending the
30	meeting in person but do not prevent the member	r from fully participating in the meeting. Examples
31	include recovering from surgery, a need to quara	ntine, or nursing of an infant.
32	(d) The Council President may approve	participation in an extraordinary situation or if a
33	member's attendance is required to achieve quor	um for a committee or Council meeting.

1	Under no circumstances may members participate from a moving venicle.

3	9.7 NOTIFICATION AND APPROVAL OF ELECTRONIC PARTICIPATION. Notification of	
4	electronic participation for any reason must be submitted by the member to the executive director	
5	of City Council Executive Director on a provided form no later than three (3)two (2) hours before	
6	the start of the meeting. Requests submitted less than two (2) hours before the start of the meetin	
7	will not be accepted and the member may not participate electronically. The member must state	
8	the reason for electronic participation and must fill out a form shall indicateing which meeting(s)	
9	they member would like to attend via electronic means. Notification of electronic participation	
10	pursuant to Rule 9.6 (a)-(c) shall not require approval. The Council President shall have the	
11	discretion to approve or deny requests submitted less than two (2) hours before the start of the	
12	meeting in an extraordinary situation or if a member's attendance is required to achieve quorum fo	
13	a committee or Council meeting. under Rule 9.6 (d).
