Purpose: In 2006, the City purchased Voting Machines with certain proprietary software systems from Sequoia Voting Systems. On or about June 4, 2010, Dominion Voting Systems acquired the assets of Sequoia Voting Systems including the proprietary software that operates the City's voting machines. This Assignment and Assumption is necessary so that Dominion will continue to perform Sequoia's obligations under the original Purchase Agreement concerning the Software Licenses and annual maintenance and support services associated with the purchased voting machines.

Scope of services with performance bench marks:

Cost/value: No cost assignment, assumption, and amendment.

Source of funds: Original Source was federal HAVA funds.

Benefit: Allows the Elections Division continued access to software systems for voting machines and annual maintenance services.

Termination provision for City and for contractor:
