A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing cash transfers from Excise Tax Funds to the General Fund.

WHEREAS, tax overperformance in the Excise Tax Base Account and the Excise Tax Reserve Funds is used to support 2C (Series 2016) excise tax commitments in the General Fund through cash transfers; and

WHEREAS, the Excise Tax Base Account is also referred to as the National Western Center/Colorado Convention Bonds-Pledged Base Fund in the City’s financial system of record;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. There is hereby authorized the transfer of cash from the National Western Center/Colorado Convention Center Bonds-Pledged Base Fund and the Excise Tax Reserve Fund to the General Fund in the amounts indicated in the following tabulation:
