Scope of work:

Bayaud Enterprises will provide the following:

1. An eligibility screening assessment for the TANF population and will direct referrals for participants with disabling condition(s) that pose a significant impact to his/her ability to identify and pursue an effective career pathway.
2. Bayaud Navigators will provide ongoing case management supports including ongoing assessment, development of Individualized Plans (IP) with the participant, and assist with engagement into workforce development activities that lead to alternative employment and self-sufficiency solutions.
3. Assist TANF participants to redirect to employment and/or to secure alternate sources of long term income, such as; Social Security Income (SSI) or Social Security Disability Income (SSDI), based on eligibility screening results.
4. Provide Bayaud Community Based Training (CBT) and Employment Services. Including development of individualized curriculum and supports based on participant learning styles, extra time and training as required, ongoing communication and continual reassessment of needs.
5. Provide Structured Assessment Placement (SAP) to assist with TANF participants in need of documentation and assessment to determine if appropriate for SSI/SSDI and/or can be rehabilitated and redirected towards employment.
