6 **A BILL**

8 **For an ordinance amending Ordinance 880, Series 1992, concerning the “Tree**
9 **Removal and Replacement” program in the Culture and Recreation Special**
10 **Revenue Fund and the means for authorizing revenues and expenditures from**
11 **said fund.**

13 **WHEREAS**, fund 15711 (formerly special fund 1518) was established by ordinance No. 880,
14 series of 1992 as the “Tree Removal and Replacement” Project Special Revenue Fund; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Parks and Recreation desires to clarify the purpose of the
16 fund;

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**
18 **DENVER:**

19 **Section 1.** That Sections 1, 2 and Section 3 of Ordinance No. 880 Series of 1992, are
20 hereby amended to read as follows:

21 “Section 1. There is hereby established in the Culture and Recreation Special
22 Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 15000, a “Public Tree Canopy” Fund, Accounting No.
23 15711-7010000, for the purpose of planting and establishing trees in public rights-of-way
24 or other public places.

25 Section 2. Monies received from any source that are payments for damage to, or loss
26 of, trees on public property, including donations, transfers, or other sources of private
27 receipts, shall be deposited in the Treasury of the City, and credited to Special Fund No.
28 15000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code
29 of the City and County of Denver.

30 Section 3. Expenditures including personnel, supplies, services, and materials are
31 hereby authorized for planning, plan review, site preparation, planting and maintenance,
32 and other related activities required to promote the successful long-term growth of new
33 trees to maintain or expand the tree canopy on public property. Expenditures are
34 authorized in Accounting No. 15711-7010000, in the amount not to exceed the total of
35 deposits described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Executive
36 Director of Parks and Recreation.” This is a non-lapsing fund.

1 **Section 2.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as
3 may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
