**A BILL**

**For an ordinance amending Section 2-145 of the Revised Municipal Code concerning adjustments to the membership of the Mayor’s Commission On Youth.**

**WHEREAS**, the mayor’s commission on youth, among other activities, provides advice and recommendations on programs and issues concerning youth, ages 12-18, living in the City and County of Denver; and

**WHEREAS**, the commission has determined it is necessary to increase and adjust its membership in order to reflect more diverse segments of the youth population in the City and County of Denver and to provide more opportunities to engage youth in the commission’s business affairs;

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That subsection A.2 .of Section 2-145 of the D.R.M.C., is hereby amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined to read as follows:

**Sec. 2-145. Advisory groups.**

A. *Mayor’s Youth commission.* An advisory commission to be known as the mayor’s youth commission is hereby created.

2. *Membership.* The mayor’s youth commission shall consist of ~~twenty-one (21)~~ twenty-eight (28) members. All members of the mayor’s youth commission shall be appointed by and shall serve at the pleasure of the mayor. The membership of the mayor’s youth commission shall reflect the ethnic, racial, and geographic constitution of the population of the city. The adjustments to members appointed under sections 2-145.A.2.a. and b. below will be made through attrition. The mayor’s youth commission shall include:

- a. ~~Eleven (11)~~ Twenty (20) members between the ages of fourteen (14) and eighteen (18) who reside in Denver at the time of appointment;
- b. ~~Five (5)~~ Four (4) members who, at the time of appointment, are employees of city agencies which serve ~~servi~~ng or support youth; and

1 c. ~~Five (5)~~ Four (4) members who, at the time of appointment, represent  
2 community agencies which serve or support ~~servi~~ng youth.
