A bill for an ordinance making a supplemental appropriation from the General Contingency Fund to the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund.

WHEREAS, the Brighton Boulevard Reconstruction Project needs budget adjustments to eliminate a funding gap based upon bids received;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the General Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the General Fund:
