- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved**
  - a. Scope of Work**

The proposed ordinance should accomplish two purposes: (1) Authorize receipt of revenue under Charter 3.2.6(e), and (2) Appropriate the funds to the fund/org/project ID This IGA will allow the City to receive and expend federal funds in the amount of 266,650 for the design phase of an ADA compliant at-grade bicycle and pedestrian crossing of the Union Pacific RR tracks at 47th Ave and York St.

The funding for this phase of the project is \$293,905 federal, (with the maximum reimburseable of \$266,650 to the City) and a required City Match of \$61,095 plus \$2,080 in non-participating costs; the funding ration is 82.79% federal and 17.21% City. The CDOT Project Nubmer is STU M320-051 and the subaccount number is 16265. The construction phase funding will be added through an amendment to this contract.
