**Scope of work:**

The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment issued a Consent to Compliance Order to DEN based upon repeated sanitary sewer overflows that had been occurring. As part of the approved corrective action plan, DEN committed to visually inspecting sanitary sewer collections with associated manholes and annually jetting the stormwater and deice water system. DEN Facilities Maintenance has been self-performing the required jetting and inspection services but due to the recent downturn in available personnel accomplishing this work has become difficult if not impossible.

Therefore, DEN Maintenance is seeking to retain a contractor to perform the required inspections for six hundred and ninety-eight (698) manholes in the sanitary sewer system, jetting of one hundred and fifty- four (154) miles of stormwater system piping, and ten (10) miles of piping in the deice water system. Jetting will be performed annually for a period of four years. For the fifth year, Contractor is required to develop a program that provides a full analysis of the entire system to be used as historical data for future cleaning and inspections of all three (3) systems. Best industry practice (BIP) dictates that most programs should be measured by documented linear feet of completion per year within a 5 to 10-year cycle to ensure a complete analogy.
