The Denver Fire Department's Wildland Firefighting Program is requesting to purchase a "Type 3" Wildland Fire Engine Apparatus. This will be used to help with wildland fires across the U.S., as well as locally in the metro area and within the state of Colorado. This unit is a non-EV (electric vehicle) and will be an internal combustion engine type. Currently there are no EV apparatus available for wildland fire fighting. Also, the infrastructure to support EV vehicle charging in remote and mountainous areas isn't currently available. The vehicle will be stored at a DFD Fire Station. The quoted purchase price is \$645,000.00. Cost Center 3522300 Fund 12825.
