10 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

11 **Section 1.** That section 14-109, D.R.M.C., is hereby amended by deleting the language  
12 stricken and adding the language underlined to read as follows:

14 **Sec. 14-109 - Salary and benefits of county court magistrates.**

16 (a) Each full time county court magistrate shall be paid a salary equal to a compa-  
17 ratio of 0.947 of the pay grade applicable to the job classification entitled "~~Assistant City~~  
18 ~~Attorney—Senior~~" "Assistant City Attorney—Section Supervisor" in the ~~then~~ current  
19 classification and pay plan adopted and maintained in accordance with chapter 18, division  
20 2 of article II.

21 (b) Each part time county court magistrate shall be paid an hourly rate equal to a  
22 compa-ratio of 0.947 of the pay grade applicable to the job classification entitled "~~Assistant~~  
23 ~~City Attorney—Senior~~" "Assistant City Attorney—Section Supervisor" in the current  
24 classification and pay plan adopted and maintained in accordance with chapter 18, division  
25 2 of article II.
