A BILL

For an ordinance making appropriations from the State Conservation Trust Fund projects.

WHEREAS, this ordinance is one of three companion ordinances for the acquisition, financing and lease of the Montbello Open Space (CB14-0838, CB14-0839 and CB14-0840) in partnership with the Trust for Public Land (TPL) for an environmental learning center run by Environmental Learning for Kids (ELK);

WHEREAS, Denver Parks and Recreation (DPR), ELK and TPL seek to purchase a vacant five acre tract of land in Montbello for the purpose of restoring the site to a short grass prairie and developing an environmental learning center operated by ELK;

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of the property will come from the City and County of Denver's State Conservation Trust Fund, Great Outdoors Colorado, Trust for Public Land and Environmental Learning for Kids;

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the State Conservation Trust Fund, Accounting No. 35000, out of monies not otherwise appropriated and in addition to amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No. 631, Series of 2013, and any supplemental appropriations or rescissions, there is hereby appropriated to the appropriation accounts hereinafter designated the amount of money following each such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
