- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved
 - a. Scope of Work

The purpose of the Resolution is to set a public hearing to approve the Globeville Commercial Urban Redevelopment Plan. The proposed Urban Redevelopment Area is located at the North West corner of 51st Avenue and Washington Street. Approximately 20% of the 78-acre site is located in Denver, the remainder in Adams County. Establishing an Urban Redevelopment Area will assist in the revitalization of a blighted and dormant site. The site may be developed into a warehouse industrial park with approximately 1 million square feet and the potential of up to 2,000 new jobs. State law requires a public hearing be held prior to approving an Urban Redevelopment Plan with 30 days notice prior to such public hearing. This Resolution sets the hearing for May 2, 2011.
