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- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved
 - a. Scope of Work

The City, with WM, wishes to sign an agreement with ASCI that allows ASCI to occupy space on top of the landfill at the DADS property to conduct asphalt shingle recycling activities that may include: (a) installation and operation of ASCI's shredding equipment, (b) temporary storage for ASCI's equipment, and (c) limited stockpiling of un-ground and ground asphalt shingles. As landfill operations dictate, the locations of asphalt stockpiles and ASCI equipment will be moved to other portions of the landfill at ASCI's costs. The location of the ASCI operations will not interfere with the landfilling operations. Additionally, the placement of an asphalt shingle recycling plant at DADS is consistent with the campus concept at the DADS property, which includes the Cityowned landfill, an area for concrete and asphalt recycling, a center for drop off of household and some construction recyclables, and the planned composting facility.

The lease term extends until December 31, 2011 and will automatically renew for 4 additional terms of 12 months each unless notice is given by one of the parties prior to the termination of the then-existing term. The base price paid per ton of finished ground asphalt shingle material shall be \$2.00 per ton. This fee will be divided 50% between the City and WM.

The City's DADS property is located at 3500 South Gun Club Road in Aurora. It is outside of Denver's City limits and therefore does not directly affect Denver Council districts.

b. Duration

The lease term extends until December 31, 2011 and will automatically renew for 4 additional terms of 12 months each unless notice is given by one of the parties prior to the termination of the then-existing term.
