8 **Levying taxes for the year 2012 upon all taxable property within special districts**
9 **within the City and County of Denver for purposes authorized by law for special**
10 **districts.**

12 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

13 **Section 1.** That there is hereby levied for the year 2012 on and against all taxable property, real,
14 personal, and mixed, within the following special districts a tax as indicated upon every dollar of assessed
15 valuation to be collected at the time and in the form and manner and with like interest and penalties as
16 other taxes are collected, to be paid monthly to the treasurers of said districts:
