- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved
 - a. Scope of Work

This request amends the existing "On Call" professional services contract to increase the contract capacity from \$2,000,000 to \$3,250,000 to allow for uninterrupted continuation of critical projects related to aboveground and underground storage tanks for up to two (2) additional years. The existing contract is in the second year of its original period of performance. The contract allows for up to two (2) one-year extensions. The purpose of the Storage Tank program is to manage storage tanks in compliance with state law and minimize city environmental liability associated with aboveground and underground storage tanks. The DEH-Environmental Quality Division coordinates, through its professional services contractor, for maintenance, repair, and testing of active city-owned storage tanks, installation of critical tank infrastructure projects, and removal of obsolete or failed storage tanks. Over the past two years DEH-EQ has taken on increased responsibility for capital costs associated with City-owned Storage Tanks, increasing the need for additional contracting capacity.
