A BILL

For an ordinance making an appropriation in the Wastewater Management Enterprise Fund.

WHEREAS, companion ordinance CB20-0302 seeks to amend an intergovernmental agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Urban Drainage Flood Control District by adding \$2,100,000 in UDFCD funds for drainage and flood control improvements along Sanderson Gulch, from Lipan Street to the South Platte River in Council District 6; and

WHEREAS, the additional \$2,100,000 brings the total UDFCD contributions to \$2,670,661.21, including the original IGA and all amendments; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, \$1,000,000 was appropriated to support the IGA; therefore, an additional ordinance is required to appropriate the remaining \$1,670,661.21;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Wastewater Management Enterprise Fund, Accounting No. 72000, out of monies not otherwise appropriated and in addition to amounts heretofore appropriated by Ordinance No. 1193, Series of 2019, and any supplemental appropriations or rescissions, there is hereby appropriated to the appropriation accounts hereinafter designated the amount of money following such designation, to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

2 agreement with the Urban Drainage Flood Control District for drainage and flood control
3 improvements along Sanderson Gulch.

6 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary
7 to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
