EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City Council approved the creation of a coordinating metro district under Title 32 of the State Statutes to be utilized as a tool in addressing the complex issues in and around the Triangle Parks located along Broadway in December of 2010. The district's purpose includes entering into agreements, coordinating volunteer efforts, making improvements to the physical environments of the parks, and seeking funding from private sources as well as governmental sources.

This resolution approves the Community Coordinating Metropolitan District No. 1 exclusion of one parcel and the inclusion of a replacement parcel and is a material modification to the Service Plan and therefore requires Council approval. This district creation was funded and championed by Amy Harmon. By statute, Title 32 districts need to have a physical location. Amy Harmon volunteered a parcel of land under her ownership to be used as the physical location of the district. The resolution moves the existing physical location of the district to the office Amy Harmon owns and works from. A pending land sale is necessitating the district's relocation. Amy Harmon serves on the Board of the Community Coordinating Metropolitan District.

Any funds the district acquires by state and federal funding sources need to be approved by the City to ensure that the district is not competing with the City for the same funding sources. All of the coordination of services will be managed by board members, service providers and volunteers. The district will continue to not have the power to tax or issue debt.
