A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Risk Management Fund (SRF 11838) Fund for Denver Parks and Recreation.

WHEREAS, Denver Parks and Recreation (DPR) is seeking approval for a capital equipment purchase of eight vehicles to replace trucks that have been in accidents and have been classified as a total loss; and

WHEREAS, said vehicles are critical to DPR operations because they are used every day in their work at all locations; and

WHEREAS, said replacement vehicles have been approved by the Department of Finance (DOF), Risk Management Division to be purchased out of Special Revenue (11838); and

WHEREAS, capital equipment items with costs above the fifty-thousand-dollar threshold require City Council authorization;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11838, the Chief Financial Officer, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

Truck	8

The foregoing vehicle purchase will support Denver Parks and Recreation operations.

2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary
3 to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
