- This is a contract amendment to an Other Transaction Agreement between the CCD and the TSA, entered into on April 26, 2012.
- The original Agreement was to design and make improvements to the seven TSA Checked Baggage Resolution Areas (CBRA's) within the Jeppesen terminal.
- The Amendment is to have the design and subsequent construction work focus on consolidating the seven current locations into two locations.
- The Agreement and the Amendment are 100% reimbursable by the TSA for the design and the construction of the final agreed design.

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CONTRACT TERMS

- The project is in the design phase.
- The City will complete design which will be reviewed and accepted by the TSA.

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- Once accepted, construction of the design will be procured through normal City practices including the appropriate Disadvantaged Business goals.
- This results in local jobs.




CBRA LOCATIONS


This project provides the Airport with a baggage collection system that, once connected to, will allow bags to be entered into the system from:
