Government & Finance

BR12- Adds \$106,736.78 to the contract with Tyler Technologies Inc. to renew the maintenance and support services for the proprietary application software CRIS+plus, i-CRIS, Personal Property and Quickdocs used for the revenue generating functions of Clerk and Recorder and Assessment and Treasury Divisions.

Health, Safety, Education & Services

BR12- Approves a first amendment to the Clayton Family Futures contract doing business as Clayton Educare to add \$564,832 and to extend the term six months through June 30, 2012, to provide Head Start services to 32 additional children for a total of 256 children served.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

- RR12- Grants a revocable permit to Mercantile Commercial to encroach into the public right-of-way with existing and new items, including stairs, ramps, railings; planter boxes and tables and chairs at 1610 16th St. in Council District 9.
- RR12- Grants a revocable permit to Spire Media to encroach into the public right-of-way with existing and new items, including a dock, stairs, guardrail, gate, awning, window jambs and a screen, at 2911 Walnut St. in Council District 9.
- RR12- Dedicates and establishes a parcel of land as part of the public right-of-0062 way of Sheridan between W. 10th and W. 13th avenues as part of the West Corridor development in Council District 3.
- RR12- Dedicates and establishes a parcel of land as part of the public right-of-0063 way of W. 14th Ave. at its intersection with Federal as part of a the West Corridor development in Council District 1.

- RR12- Dedicates and establishes a parcel of land as part of the public right-of-0064 way of Federal between W. 14th and W. 12th avenues as part of the West Corridor development in Council Districts 1 and 3.
- BR12- Amends a contract with Deighton Associates Limited to extend it for the second year of the four-year term and increase the amount \$149,990 to a maximum of \$603,312 for technical services to include pavement/asset management for the City's street, alley and bridge network.

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion. If approved, items are placed on the Mayor-Council agenda the following week. This document outlines the items that were placed on consent agendas this week.
