A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing the granting of a Permanent Easement, a Temporary Easement, and a Declaration of Access Control Restrictions to the Colorado Department of Transportation relating to the Bronco Arch Bridge Project.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:
