- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved
 - a. Scope of Work

The proposed ordinance is for the approval of an IGA with UDFCD for final design, right-of-way acquisition and construction of channel improvements along Cherry Creek from Monaco Parkway to Iliff Boulevard. The purpose of the project is to design drop structures within Cherry Creek to stabilize the channel. The current IGA calls for funding of final design; additional funding for right-of-way acquisition and construction is expected to be provided by future amendments to this agreement.

b. Duration

The term of agreement commences upon final execution by all parties and will terminate three years after the final payment is made to the construction contractor. Certain elements of the IGA – Floodplain Regulation, Ownership of Property and Limitation of Use, and Maintenance – run in perpetuity.
