Executive Summary Projects Funded with General Obligation Bonds, Series 2010D

The following is a preliminary list provided by the Better Denver Bond Project Team which identifies the projects that will receive funds from the issuance of Series 2010D General Obligation Bonds as authorized by the Better Denver Bond Program approved by voters in 2007.

Upon issuance of the Series 2010D Bonds, the remaining unissued bond authorization will consist primarily of the project savings identified by the Project Team and the costs for the remodeling of the Boettcher Concert Hall. None of the 2010D bond proceeds will be used for the Boettcher Concert Hall improvements.
