The City of Denver is working with the Denver Connection West Metropolitan District to build a \$8M park in Far Northeast Denver. The district is committing a significant amount of funding and the land to create a beautiful public space in this growing neighborhood. The completed park will be turned over the DPR. As outlined in DPR's Naming Policy and Gift Policy, with a gift this significant, the donor can choose to name the parcel, as long as it meets DPR's naming criteria. The District Board has agreed to name this park "Amache Prowers Memorial Park", which has also been vetted through a community led process for a near by park.
