## 6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

DPR is asking to modify Ordinance No. 80 of Series 2005 (Council Bill No. 49) and Ordinance No. 651 of Series 2008 (Council Bill No. 638) to make changes to SRFs 15821-701000 (Facility Rental Program) and 15824-701000 (Citywide Sports Program), respectively. Specifically, DPR requests that the new ordinance language allows for the following:

- \$30,000 of budget plus enough budget to cover outstanding encumbrances roll forward at the close of the year for SRF 15821-701000.
- \$40,000 of budget plus enough budget to cover outstanding encumbrances roll forward at the close of the year for SRF 15824-701000.

DPR seeks this change in order to cover salaries/benefits at the start of the following year and to cover previous years' encumbrances for items ordered at the end of the previous year but which are not received until the beginning of the following year.

This has been an issue for several years because both SRFs are set up on a cash basis, and the current ordinances proscribe that both funds "shall begin each new calendar year with a zero cash and budget balance," which causes problems at the beginning of each year, before the cash levels are sufficient to establish enough budget to cover program costs.
