Starting July 2007, Denver Arts & Venues entered into an agreement with the Town of Morrison originally to provide traffic control services for the Red Rocks Amphitheater for various events. No longer able to provide the services of which the City of Denver will now provide services directly, this new agreement is replacing the existing agreement to allow City of Denver to maintain traffic control services. The City will compensate the Town of Morrison with a license fee to allow Denver officers to be present in Morrison. Funds used to pay the license fee are covered through collected funds established in booking agreements with promoters.
