## FERNANDO SERGIO

With over 19 years in broadcast media, Fernando Sergio is a widely respected and recognized voice in Colorado, offering a solid combination of experience, charisma, competence, and integrity –something that has resonated well with Denver’s Spanish-language radio audience. Fernando’s academic background in Business Political Science and Communication equips him with the knowledge to address a broad range of subjects that concern the Hispanic community.

After finishing his enlistment in the U.S. Army and being honorably discharged, he began his successful career in 1994 as evening host on KBNO Radio in Denver and later became the PM drive host. In 1995 Fernando was cast as the Spanish voice of the Denver Broncos and the Denver Nuggets. He remained the official Spanish voice of the Denver Broncos for 16 years and was fortunate to be the first Spanish broadcaster from a local flagship station to call two Super Bowl games.

Fernando also worked in the Telemundo network first as sports anchor and then as their official newscaster and voice in the Hispanic community. He co-produced numerous community oriented segments such as “De Frente,” a show that focused on political matters directly related to the Hispanic community

In 2005 Fernando returned to the radio airwaves on KBNO as producer and host of a very unique program, one of great importance to Denver’s Hispanic community – where local issues are discussed, and national as well as international subjects are covered. The show, “La Voz del Pueblo,” has been perhaps the most successful local radio program in the Denver metro area and Colorado Springs, Spanish radio markets.

The primary purpose of this show is to lend a helping hand to those in need. Whether dealing with immigration, unemployment, employment abuse, fraud, police community relations, banking, mortgage, vehicle purchases, construction projects and many other issues that matter to the Hispanic Community. Fernando takes the time to help listeners find a solution to their problems and in many cases he personally accompanies his/her listeners to court hearings or arbitration, depending on the circumstances.

He has partnered with a number of non-profit organizations to promote their services and serve as a liaison between his vast audience and these organizations.
