Cameron's work has centered on building inclusive systems through education, community engagement, and public advocacy. He began his career in Denver Public Schools as a teacher at Bruce Randolph School, where he worked closely with students, families, and educators to improve access and outcomes. He later led community engagement and policy advocacy efforts at Colorado Common Cause, organizing hundreds of Coloradans during the state's redistricting process and supporting legislation to protect voters and strengthen democracy.

Today, Cameron works nationally to support LGBTQ equality through the Gill Foundation's OutGiving Network and serves in leadership and advisory roles with New Era Colorado and Colorado Common Cause. Across these roles, he has collaborated with nonprofit leaders, public officials, and community members to advance fairness, accountability, and inclusion. Cameron is proud to bring his lived experience, collaborative leadership style, and deep commitment to Denver's LGBTQ community to public service.
