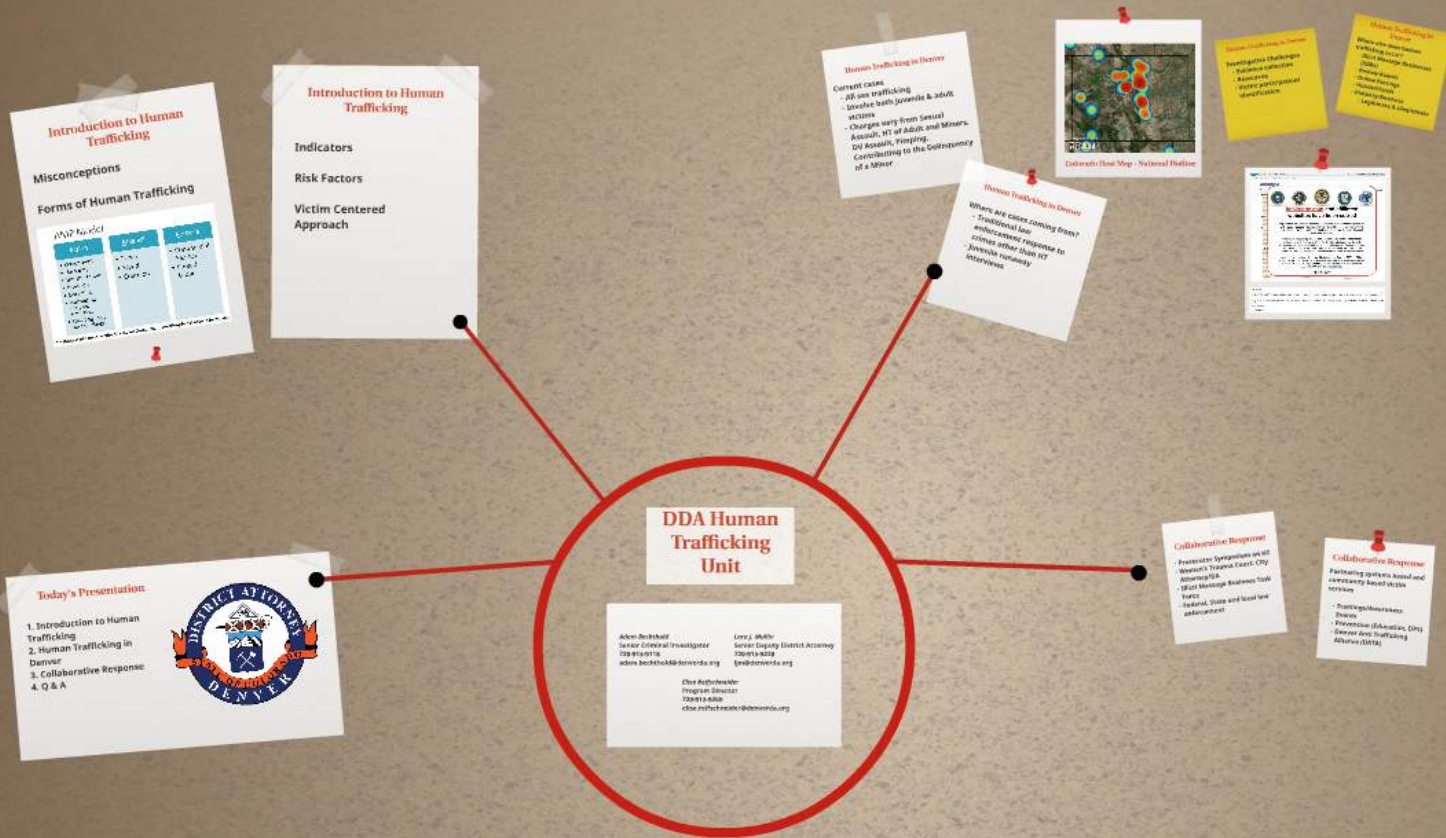
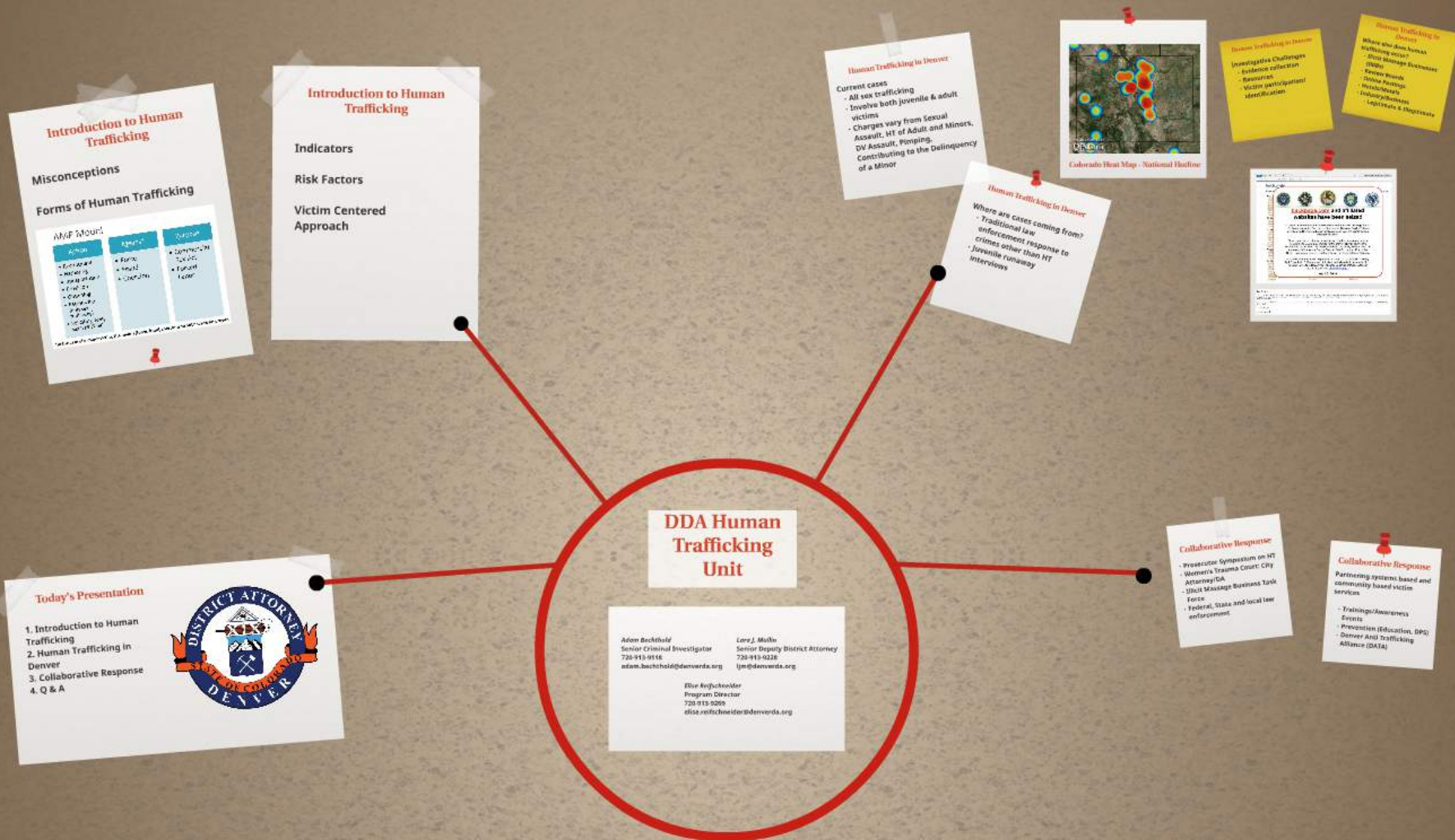

Forms of Human Trafficking

AMP Model

Action	Means*	Purpose
• Recruitment • Harboring • Transportation • Provision • Obtaining • Patronizing (only sex trafficking) • Soliciting (only sex trafficking)	• Force • Fraud • Coercion	• Commercial Sex Act • Forced Labor

*In the case of a minor victim, the means (force, fraud, coercion) do not have to be proven

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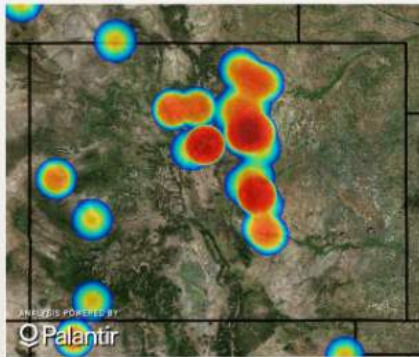
Human Trafficking in Denver
