- 2.1. Safety Reporting capability: Enable users to efficiently report incidents, near-misses, and safety concerns.
- 2.2. Safety Assurance capability: Support safety process data, including investigations, corrective actions, and auditing.
- 2.3. Safety Risk Management capability: Assist in identifying, assessing, and mitigating safety hazards.
- 2.4. Safety Promotion capability: Facilitate safety awareness and training programs.
- 2.5. Safety Reporting Mobile App: Provide a mobile application for on-the-go incident reporting for both online and offline use.
- 2.6. Safety Assurance Mobile App Integration: Integrate mobile apps for safety assurance/reporting for online and offline use.
- 2.7. Dynamic dashboard with drill-down ability to deliver urgent information, key deadlines, and statistics in easy-to-read visuals.
- 2.8. Record keeping for a minimum of 36 months.
- 2.9. Hazard and risk mitigation tracking and reminders.
- 2.10. The ability to associate corrective actions to hazards.
- 2.11. Streamlined process to conduct and manage Audits, Evaluations, Investigations, and Inspections.
- 2.12. Customizable and configurable templates for checklists.
- 2.13. Customizable and configurable newsletter and survey templates.
- 2.14. Customizable and configurable templates for safety reports.
- 2.15. Ability to link multiple safety reports from different employee groups to one safety event.
- 2.16. Query and data visualization tools for analysis of safety reports.
- 2.17. Intuitive interface for submitting, processing, and analyzing safety reports.
- 2.18. Centralized safety risk management processes.
- 2.19. Hazard and risk register for visibility of all hazards and associated risk levels.
