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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Oversight for City Asbestos, Lead-Based Paint, and Indoor Air Quality Issues

City Bond and Captital Improvement projects have increased the use of this on-call professional services City consultant. Walsh Environmental Scientists and Engineers, LLC has been tasked to oversee and coordinate numerous asbestos issues and ensure compliance with State, Federal, & local regulations. Increased work has lead to the potential to exceed the existing maximum contract value before the contract term expires. DEH requests an increase in contact value to ensure asbestos and other abatement oversight services can be provided until new contracts can be procured.
