Approves the mayoral appointment of Brian Gerber to the Board of Environmental Health for a term effective immediately and expiring December 31, 2015. The Committee approved filing this resolution by consent on 1-27-11.

Accepts \$208,214.22 reimbursement from the state for cleanup of City leaking underground storage tank site at Fire Station 28, located at 4306 S. Wolff St. (RC91008-2). CB11-0013 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Clayton Family Futures dba Clayton Educare, to provide Head Start services to 198 children. (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION & SERVICES)

Extends the current Head Start contract with Clayton Family Futures for one year and increases funding by \$599,158. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 2-28-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 1-27-11.

CB11-0014 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Mile High Montessori Early Learning Centers, to provide Head Start services to 275 children. (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION & SERVICES)

Extends for one year and adds \$895,296 to the Head Start contract with Mile High Montessori Early Learning Centers (GE00333-1). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 2-28-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 1-27-11.

CB11-0015 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Volunteers of America, to provide Head Start services to 85 children. (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION & SERVICES)

Extends for one year and adds \$256,859 to the Head Start contract with Volunteers of America for a total of \$504,955. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 2-28-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 1-27-11.

CB11-0019 A bill for an ordinance authorizing the purchase of capital equipment items from the "Urban Areas Security Initiative FY09" Special Revenue Fund budget. (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION & SERVICES)

Approves procuring a Tactical Response Vehicle, not to exceed \$350,000, on behalf of Adams County through FY09 Urban Area Security Initiative funds. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 1-27-11.

CB11-0021 A bill for an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of

Denver and the United States of America concerning the "Shelter Plus Care Durkin Project FY10-11" program and the funding therefor. (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION & SERVICES)

Accepts \$312,180 in federal funds to provide 49 units of sponsor based rental assistance for the Durkin project to help chronically homeless individuals with mental illnesses obtain and remain in housing (GC01075). The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 1-27-11.

CB11-0022 A bill for an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America concerning the "Shelter Plus Care Rental Assistance-Scattered Sites FY10-11" program and the funding therefor. (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION & SERVICES)

Accepts \$437,328 in federal funds to provide 49 units of sponsor based rental assistance at scattered sites to help chronically homeless individuals with mental illnesses obtain and remain in housing (GC01077). The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 1-27-11.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

CB11-0051 A bill for an ordinance approving the second on call amendatory agreement between Humphries Poli Architects and the City & County of Denver to increase funding and modify agreement. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Amends the contract with Humphries Poli Architects to add \$480,000, for a new total of \$1,440,000, for design work on municipal building remodeling, retrofitting, and renovation projects. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 2-28-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 1-27-11.

CB11-0079 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Conditional and Preliminary Joint DOT-HUD Term Sheet for Planning Grants between the City and County of Denver and United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and United States Department of Transportation to accept federal transit-oriented development planning grant. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Approves a security personnel contract with HSS, Inc. in the total contract amount of \$30 million to provide professional security services at various City facilities. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 2-22-11. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 1-19-11.

CB10-1013 A bill for an ordinance approving a Second Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and ACS State & Local Solutions, Inc., to provide the Child Support Enforcement Division with an in-house call center and provide customer service and support. (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION & SERVICES)

Adds \$452,512 to and extends the contract with ACS State & Local Solutions, Inc. through 12-31-11 to provide child support enforcement call center services. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 2-22-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 11-15-10.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

CB10-1111 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between CTM, Inc. d/b/a Colorado Total Maintenance and the City & County of Denver for landscape improvements and irrigation construction services. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Adds \$635,454.04 to the on-call landscape and irrigation services contract with Colorado Total Maintenance for a new contract amount of \$2,135,454.04. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 2-22-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-23-10.

CB10-1112 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Goodland Construction, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for landscape improvements and irrigation construction services. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Adds \$606,632.39 to the on-call landscape and irrigation services contract with Goodland Construction for a new contract amount of \$2,206,853.94. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 2-22-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-23-10.

CB10-1113 A bill for an Ordinance approving a third amendatory agreement between the City and County of Denver and T2 Construction for on-call landscape and irrigation services. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Adds \$698,471.20 to the on-call landscape and irrigation services contract with T2 Construction for a new contract amount of \$2,198,471.20. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 2-22-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-23-10.

CB11-0011 A bill for an ordinance relinquishing certain easements reserved in Ordinance No. 24, Series of 1939. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Relinquishes easements in the alley bounded by Walnut, 11th and 12th streets and Auraria Parkway which were reserved by ordinance in 1939 in Council District 9. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on

2-22-11. Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 1-20-11.

CB11-0012 A bill for an ordinance vacating a portion of Walnut Street, without reservations. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Vacates a 737 square-foot portion of right-of-way at 319 Walnut in Council District 9. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 1-20-11.
