A BILL

For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund for the “Colorado Convention Center”.

WHEREAS, the Department of Finance requests a new fund for the “Colorado Convention Center” to service the Colorado Convention Center; and

WHEREAS, appropriations will be made during the annual budget process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund, Accounting No. 38000, a “Colorado Convention Center” fund, Accounting No. 38422 for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.

Section 2. Monies received from Facilities Development Admission (a/k/a Seat Tax) generated annually at the Colorado Convention Center (CCC), Denver Convention Center Hotel Authority Excess Revenue, City share of Tourism Improvement District’s (TID) revenues, the 2C ballot measure funding dedicated to capital maintenance at the CCC, interest, and other sources of revenue including transfers from other City funds, shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.


Section 3. Allowable expenditures include those that are necessary to make future COP debt payments, hold required debt reserves, and to provide direct funding or cash transfers for capital improvement projects for the CCC. This is an appropriated, non-lapsing fund.

1 **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
