6 **A BILL**

8 **For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the General Government Special**  
9 **Revenue Fund for the “Climate Federal Grants” program.**  
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12 **WHEREAS**, the Office of Climate Action, Sustainability, and Resiliency (CASR) was  
13 established in the past year to elevate and expand the City and County of Denver’s climate  
14 initiatives; and

15 **WHEREAS**, CASR is pursuing grant funds to further its impact, including federal grants, but  
16 currently lacks a fund to administer them;  
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18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
19 **DENVER:**

21 **Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue  
22 Fund, Accounting No. 11000, a “Climate Federal Grants” Fund, Accounting No. 11010, for the  
23 purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of federal grants awarded to the Office of  
24 Climate Action, Sustainability and Resiliency.

25 **Section 2.** Monies received from federal awards supporting climate, sustainability, and/or  
26 resilience initiatives shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special  
27 Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised  
28 Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

29 **Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Climate Federal Grants” Fund,  
30 Accounting No. 11010, in the amount not to exceed the amounts awarded as described in Section  
31 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Office of Climate Action,  
32 Sustainability and Resiliency or his or her designate or other authorized officials. This Fund is  
33 sponsor-funded and non-lapsing.

1       **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be  
3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
