The City and County of Denver is seeking to purchase obtain fifty-five (55) Ford Interceptor Patrol cars from Spradley/Barr Ford, Inc. The proposed agreement is a zero dollar agreement that will allow the City to obtain the equipment and a companion agreement with Chase Equipment Finance, Inc., who is the financier.
