(2) Xanthia Ct., from 26th Ave. north to 28th Ave., the land in the following described area:

Tract B, Stapleton Filing No. 3, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

(3) 26th Ave., from Xanthia St. east to and through Xanthia Ct., the land in the following described area:

Tract C, Stapleton Filing No. 3, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;
