Dear Happy,

I am writing this letter of support for the official renaming of what has been called Northside Park to Carpio Sanguinetti Park. This park is located at the site of Denver's abandoned wastewater treatment plant located in Globeville, adjacent to the South Platte River.

As you remember, we knew Sal Carpio as a dignified, quiet and brilliant Denver Councilmember who not only represented Globeville but saved it. His work on Council included writing the Registered Neighborhood Notification Ordinance that empowered community organizations in Denver and elevated them to true participants in the future of the city. When the Denver Planning Board decided that Globeville would make a great industrial park, Sal was elected to City Council and blocked the change. He was the force behind the creation of this very park which replaced the abandoned Municipal treatment plant. This park has served the Globeville community ever since.

Our growing shortage of urban parks demands that the city, if there is a way, expand this excellent replacement for the sewage treatment plant as a proud Denver park honoring one of the best members of Council in my memory.
