This Ordinance will authorize a contract with Signal Behavioral Health Network in the amount of \$725,000 to provide onsite substance abuse treatment Coordinators that will assist the County in delivering a full continuum of care (Outpatient, Intensive Outpatient, Transitional Residential, Intensive Residential, Therapeutic Community, Detoxification, or comparable alternatives as mutually agreed upon) substance abuse treatment services to child welfare clients.
