Contract Description

- Saab Sensis provides a computer software program that facilitates the safe and efficient movement of aircraft on the airfield
- Amendment will provide for the purchase of additional sensors that will track the movement of aircraft on the airfield
- Effective in 2014, the FAA will no longer perform this function or provide information to the airport

DENVER

- Contract awarded via a Request for Proposal and competitive selection process
- Four proposals were received when advertised in August
 2009
- There was not a previous incumbent
- The selection panel consisted of DIA Finance, Commercial,
 Technology, and Airport Operations Division, United and
 Frontier Airlines management staff

Selection Process (cont.)

DENVER

- The selection criteria consisted of software capability, report design and generation capabilities, and technical support
- Saab Sensis is based in Syracuse, New York
- Saab Sensis employs four hundred and eighty four (484)
 management and technical staff

Goals

 There are no goals established since Saab Sensis provides a proprietary software product that they also support

DENVER

There are no subcontractors that are proposed for this contract

Contract Terms and Amount

- Original contract term: June 2010 June 2013
 - The contract included software implementation, nine (9) airfield sensors, and a service agreement
- Original Contract Amount: \$2,750,000
- Amended contract term:
 - From approval date through December 2015
 - Amendment will provide for twenty-four (24) additional airfield sensors, a new software program for managing winter deicing operations, and a service agreement through December 2015
- The amended contract amount is \$6,350,000
