6 **for an ordinance amending the classification and pay plan for employees in the**
7 **Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service.**

9 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Charter section 9.1.1 (D) and section 18-5 (a), D.R.M.C., the career
10 service board has conducted the annual survey of generally prevailing pay rates and has
11 recommended classification and pay plan adjustments to the mayor and city council for all
12 classifications in the career service and for certain classifications not in the career service: and
13 **WHEREAS**, the city council has determined to accept the recommendation of the career service board
14 and implement the classification and pay plan adjustments in the manner set forth in section 18-5 (b),
15 D.R.M.C.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**
17 **DENVER:**

18 **Section 1.** That the current classification plans and pay schedules for all employees in the
19 career service and for those employees not in the career service, as fully set forth in the Office of the
20 Clerk and Recorder, Clerk Filing No: 11-330, is hereby adopted.

21 **Section 2.** This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 2011.
