A BILL

For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States concerning the "Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) FY14" program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the United States has tendered to the City a Grant award for said program; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement, under CFDA No. 14.231, between the United States of America and the City and County of Denver, which is identified as Grant Number E-14-MC-08-0003, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 14-0659, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the United States to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 13000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said programs, to be expended by the Manager of Human Services:

The foregoing authorization will provide a stable source of funds to help meet emergency services needed to address the amelioration of poverty. Authorization for expenditure of said funds following execution of said grant will cover the period from July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015.

3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
