**A BILL**

**For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the General Government Special Revenue Fund Series for elections equipment, technology, civic engagement and other needs in the “Elections Equipment and Technology” Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Clerk and Recorder has a need to purchase new and replacement elections equipment, and to fund equipment leases, storage and other space needs, one-time start-up civic engagement needs, and technology; and

**WHEREAS**, companion ordinance CB19-1174 rescinds up to \$1,800,000 from the Clerk and Recorder’s General Fund appropriation, which is available due to year-end savings, and re-appropriates said budget into the Elections Equipment and Technology Special Revenue Fund, to be established through this ordinance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund Series, Accounting No. 11000, an “Elections Equipment and Technology” Fund, Accounting No. 11874, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.

**Section 2.** Monies received from General Fund transfers and other sources of revenue for Accounting No. 11874 shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Elections Equipment and Technology Fund”, Accounting No. 11874, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of this ordinance to be expended by the Clerk and Recorder. Allowable expenditures include new and replacement elections equipment, leases for elections equipment and space, storage and other space needs, technology including software or other applications, and start-up costs related to civic engagement efforts. This Fund is revenue-based and non-lapsing.

1       **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary  
3 to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
