- BR14-0321 Amends the Classification and Pay Plan by reordering and aligning the pay grades and rates of intern, trainee, and fellow classes to the appropriate pay grade and occupational group.

- BR14- Amends a contract with Pinyon Environmental, Inc. to extend the

- BR14-0314 Approves a contract with Dellenbach Motors in the amount of \$530,974 to purchase 14 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 pickup trucks for Denver Parks & Recreation (PWOPS0000010363).
