The contractor will provide residential service coordinators, case managers, and 31 rental units to families and individuals whose income is equal to or less than 30% -50% of the area median gross income. Coordinators will focus on youth in core programs: education and community participation. Education may include referrals to education services, physical activity, and recreation. Community Participation may includes community safety initiatives, community projects, and events. Case Manager will develop an Individualized Action Plan (IAP) for residents in core programs: health and wellness, financial stability, and economic development. Health and Wellness may include referrals to behavioral health care, referrals to preventative, primary and health care. Financial Stability may include seminars, employment, and job readiness support. Economic Development may include education on housing stability and eviction prevention coaching, and work on the goals set in the IAP.
