

Current Roles: Produce and host middays (10a-3p) in Zetta. Produce, host, and program three specialty shows using Zetta and MusicMaster. Write and host band interviews and Guest DJ Sessions and edit them in Audition. Track records from Colorado bands for on-air play and program monthly feature Local 303. Write entertainment content for website. Record voicework for station promotions and underwriting. Lead on-air fundraising three times per year. Engage via social media and public appearances as station ambassador at community events. Established relationships with label and radio promoters. Regular guest and music expert on CPR News and NPR Music contributor. Co-Host of The Playlist League, a podcast from Colorado Public Radio, currently on hiatus. Host of the television program OpenAir Live and Local, a companion to the radio on Colorado Public Television, on hiatus after five seasons.
