Grant funds were awarded to the City and County of Denver through the State of Colorado Natural Resource Trustees, Natural Resource Damages, Rocky Mountain Arsenal Restoration Grant program. The State of Colorado settled a lawsuit for natural resource damages resulting from past activities at the Rocky Mountain Arsenal with Shell Oil Company and the United States Army for \$27.4 million to restore natural resources in the South Platte River area. The award to Denver and several other awarded proposals will incur the total remaining funds available from the State. Matching funds have been obtained through the prior CIP budgeting process.
