Unexpectedly, a number of these projects have assitioned into larger and more complicated projects. As a result, only \$60 thousand in contract capacity is available and a number of jor park design projects remain uncompleted. One of the largest of these design contracts is to provide technical services in support agreement with CDOT and the City to rebuild 6 th Avenue, and reconstruct Barnum Park. Other substantial projects include the DCO grant-funded River Vision project that will require the expanded capacity of this contract. Parks Department recommends ending the Architerra contract to add \$290,000 in additional capacity for the existing contract term.
