Permanent Supportive Housing for Homeless Persons with Special Needs

Permanent Supportive Housing: This is accomplished through rental assistance and supportive services and targeted to persons with chronic illnesses, disabilities, mental health issues, substance use disorders or other disabilities who have experienced long-term or repeated homelessness.

Eligible Activities: rental assistance and administration

Match: 25% of grant award and may be cash or in-kind

Goals: housing stability, income and self-sufficiency
